Lesson 1: Laying the Foundation

Tuesday, June 19, 2012

Lesson 1 will lay the foundation. You'll begin by understanding your current paper situation and create a compelling paper organizing goal statement. Next, you'll take steps to slow down the flow of paper into your home to ensure ongoing success in keeping paper clutter at bay.

Lesson 2: The Paper Organizing Process: Collect + Decide

In Lesson 2, you'll learn a simple decision making process, allowing you to confidently categorize and process all of your paper—from the daily mail to your paper backlog. You'll also set up an area to sort your paper so you can begin managing the daily inflow and digging out of backlog.

In Lesson 5, the focus will shift to your archive paper—paper you want or need to hold onto for longer periods of time, but don't need to access regularly. You'll learn how to set up your archive systems and continue the process of sorting and organizing your paper backlog.

In Lesson 6, we'll wrap up the workshop by discussing how to use, tweak, and maintain your systems going forward.
